324th Fighter Group (to which the 99th Fighter Squadron was attached)

316th Service Group (detachment#99 of this group worked with the 366th

Service Squadron during April 1944). 366 Service Squadron (later 366 Air Service Squadron) was apparently attached to this group in the spring of 1944.

38th Air Service Group (to which the 366th Air Service Squadron, the 1000th Signal Company, the 1249th Engineer Composite Platoon, and the 1765th Ordnance Service and Maintenance Company were assigned). 366 Service Squadron (later, 366 Air Service Squadron) was apparently attached to this group while it remained assigned to the 96th Service Group (later 96th Air Service Group) until early April 1945.
